Design an ANA Airplane

September 30 (Sun)

ANA is accepting entries for aircraft body designs in commemoration of our 60th anniversary.

The selected designs will take to the sky painted onto a (domestic route) Boeing 767-300!

- 1) The winning design will be painted onto an aircraft body!
- 2 The winner receives a model plane with the winning design painted on it!
- 3 The winner receives two invitations to attend the unveiling event.

1) Creators of winning designs each receive two invitations to attend the unveiling event.

50 names will be drawn by lottery from among all entrants to receive a pair of seats at the unveiling event.

Important information about the airolane unveiling event * ANA will provide round-trip air tickets to the Grand Prize winners and winning design creators from their homes to Tokyo. * Winners of the second chance prize must bear the transportation and other costs involved in attending the event. * The airplane unveiling event is scheduled to be held at Haneda Airport or Narita Airport in mid-February 2013.

• Submission by web: Draw the design on the entry form, then submit the design as an image file to the contest site

[Grand Prize design] Selection procedure: From the winning designs in each category, one design will be selected based on voting by customers and ANA Group employees.


